# Writing a Reasonable and Doable Business Plan

## Purpose of a Business Plan

- Some are written to help the business owner document the elements of their business
- Others are written to provide potential lenders the information they need to make lending decisions
- In all cases, business plans "connect the dots" about a business



### **How Many Pages?**

- The number of pages is far less important than the quality of the content
- All business plans cover certain basic content (the order may change depending on how you want/need to present your business plan story)
  - **Executive Summary** short, usually 1 page, summary of your business plan
  - **Business Profile** about the business, ownership, industry
  - Market Research the key drivers of the decisions you made in the sections that follow
  - **Products & Services** what you make and/or sell or services you provide
  - Marketing & Sales marketing = how people learn about your business and products & services and sales = how you generate revenue
  - Operations how the business functions; what the business does vs what you choose to do externally (outsourced; esp. manufacturing & distribution where applicable)
  - Management who leads the business and their qualifications
  - Human Resources what are the staffing needs (type, timing) for the business
  - Financials historical (3 yrs if possible) and projected (preferably 3 yrs) sales, expenses, and cashflow projections; your gross margin; key financial assumptions; financing req'd
- Various tools and techniques for developing your content:
  - <u>Lean Canvas</u> planning tool
  - Building a Go To Market Strategy (to be added to the Toolkit in the near future)
  - Marketing Strategies (to be added to the Toolkit in the near future)
  - o **Financial Model Template** (to be added to the Toolkit in the near future)


